## Living the (Literal) High Life in L.A.

The next status symbol for pampered bizzers will undoubtedly be a pad at Century City's 40-story Ten Thousand residential tower, which opens later this year with 283 two- and three-bedroom apartments. Described as a resort building with state-of-the-art security and privacy, it will have amenities



including a curated art collection in the lobby, two boardrooms with video conferencing, a dog run, wine storage, basketball court, private park, free fitness classes, and indoor and outdoor pools. Technological innovations include touchscreen "predictive services" designed to simplify life. If all that's not enough, private butlers and a fleet of luxury cars with drivers should be able to satisfy residents' every need. Units will be priced at \$8,000 to \$25,000 per month.
